Characteristic of the artist's Portrait artwork is a meticulous attention to detail, excellent realism, and artistic insight. Working primarily in Colored Pencil for Portrait work, Johnson notes this medium brings a high level of control for detail, color, tone, and the delicacy to represent textures and tones with greatest accuracy.

How to Commission a Portrait

It is time to unearth those favorite photographs! It's helpful for the photos to be well focused for detail.

Your initial contact with the artist can be via phone, email, or by mailing in the form on the right. We will plan this together!

You will get a firm quote for your Portrait Commission from the artist, a contract will be signed, a partially refundable deposit paid, and your Portrait will be completed most often within 2 weeks ! Upon your acceptance of the artwork, the balance of the fee will be paid & your Portrait will be shipped to you!
